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

A Historic Commitment to Peace and Security

Founding Member of the OAU/AU committed to Peace

Algeria is one of the founding countries of the OAU/AU. It has actively contributed to promoting African integration and strengthening institutional mechanisms for better continental governance.

African Solutions to African Problems

Over decades, Algeria has contributed to the peaceful resolution of crises by facilitating national and regional dialogues. It has promoted approaches based on respect for national sovereignty and the inclusivity of stakeholders.



STRUCTURING AND INTEGRATIVE PROJECTS AT THE CONTINENTAL LEVEL

Algeria has invested in strategic infrastructure, including cross-border transport networks, to strengthen regional economic integration and improve connectivity among African countries. These projects foster stability and create economic opportunities on a continental scale.

TRAINING AND KNOWLEDGE TRANSFER

Algeria offers a wide range of scholarships and training programs to African countries in key sectors, including scientific fields such as artificial intelligence, medicine, pharmacy, aeronautics, petrochemicals, information and communication technologies, and agriculture. These initiatives strengthen African human capital and encourage the sharing of best practices.

RECOGNIZED EXPERTISE IN THE AFRICAN PEACE AND SECURITY ARCHITECTURE (APSA)

CONTRIBUTION TO THE CREATION OF THE PSC

Algeria played a central role in drafting the Protocol establishing the Peace and Security Council in 2002. It continues to provide its strategic expertise to strengthen and adapt mechanisms for the prevention, management, and resolution of conflicts in response to emerging security challenges.

AU CHAMPION IN THE FIGHT AGAINST TERRORISM

Recognizing Algeria's unique and pioneering experience in combating terrorism, the African Union gave Algeria in 2017 the mandate to serve as Coordinator for the Prevention and the Fight Against Terrorism and Violent Extremism in Africa. Under the visionary leadership of the President of the Republic, Mr. Abdelmadjid Tebboune, this role has been instrumental in shaping concrete strategies and actionable recommendations, which have been adopted by the African Union Conference of Heads of State and Government. These efforts have significantly bolstered the continent's ability to tackle security threats.



SUPPORT FOR COLLECTIVE AU INITIATIVES

HOST OF AU INSTITUTIONS

Algeria hosts the African Centre for the Study and Research on Terrorism (ACSRT, formerly CAERT) and the African Police Cooperation Mechanism (AFRIPOL). These institutions play a crucial role in coordinating continental responses to security threats and strengthening member states' capacities to combat terrorism.

PRESIDENCY OF NARC AND LOGISTICAL REINFORCEMENT

As the current Chair of the North African Regional Capability (NARC), Algeria has operationalized strategic infrastructure, such as the Jijel logistics base, to support African forces within the African Standby Force (ASF). This operational role enhances the rapidity and effectiveness of deployments in crisis situations.

ROLE IN INTELLIGENCE PLATFORMS

Algeria has played a decisive role in the creation and functioning of the Joint Operational Staff Committee (CEMOC), the Fusion and Liaison Unit (UFL), and the Committee of Intelligence and Security Services of Africa (CISSA). These mechanisms enhance regional and continental coordination in responding to transnational security threats.







AFRICA'S VOICE ON THE INTERNATIONAL STAGE

ACTIVE REPRESENTATION AT THE UN SECURITY COUNCIL (UNSC)

As a non-permanent member for the 2024-2025 period, Algeria plays a central role in strengthening Africa's voice within the A3+ Group. It actively advocates for African priorities in peace, security, and development discussions. Committed to ensuring that the continent's concerns are fully reflected in the Security Council's strategic decisions, Algeria places particular emphasis on issues related to counterterrorism, conflict resolution, and humanitarian crisis.

ADDRESSING AFRICA'S HISTORICAL INJUSTICE

Algeria plays a key role within the Committee of Ten (C-10), which promotes the Common African Position on UN Security Council reform. It actively advocates for addressing the historical injustice endured by Africa and ensuring fair and legitimate representation of the continent, in line with its demographic, economic, and political weight on the international stage.

THE ORAN PROCESS

For over a decade, Algeria has hosted the High-Level Seminar on Peace and Security in Africa, known as the "Oran Process." This strategic platform brings together PSC member states and the A3+ to coordinate African positions on key peace and security issues. The Oran Process has strengthened synergies between African and international mechanisms while promoting sustainable solutions, tailored to the continent's needs.

VISION FOR THE 2025-2028 MANDATE

- Strengthening Early Warning Systems: Algeria is committed to working with member states and African institutions to improve early warning systems that detect early indicators of conflicts and crises. By combining modern technologies with local expertise, Algeria seeks to foster a proactive approach to prevent conflicts effectively through rapid and well-coordinated actions.
- Supporting Peacekeeping Operations: Algeria will continue to provide financial, logistical, and technical support to AU peacekeeping operations. It will work to strengthen the capacities of the African Standby Force through tailored training and logistical support based on its strategic infrastructures, such as the Jijel logistics base.
- Promoting National Reconciliation: Convinced that lasting peace requires inclusive reconciliation, Algeria will support national and regional mechanisms that foster dialogue among stakeholders. It will leverage its experience in mediation and facilitation to assist social, political, and economic reconstruction processes.
- Combating Terrorism and Transnational Crime: As a leading force in counterterrorism in Africa, Algeria will continue to enhance cross-border cooperation and intelligence sharing among member states. It will advocate for comprehensive and integrated approaches to address complex threats in coordination with African security mechanisms such as AUCTC and AFRIPOL.
